

1. Nature and Purpose of the Service

The IELTS Speaking Mock Exam is a **diagnostic and developmental service** designed to help candidates understand their **current speaking level** and identify **specific areas for improvement** based on the official IELTS Speaking assessment criteria.

2. What the Service Includes
